OBTAINING A LIFE HEIGHT CERTIFICATE FOR MICRO-CHIPPED HORSES

The Royal Agricultural Society of NZ, in consultation with the Morgan Horse Association of NZ, has developed the following procedures for dealing with the LIFE MEASUREMENT of Part and Pure Bred Morgan Horses.

When applying for a Life Height Certificate for your Part or Pure Bred Morgan that is carrying a Micro-Chip, all of the rules of the Royal Agricultural Society apply *with the exception that*, where a Micro-Chip Scanner is available at the measuring day, a Royal Agricultural Society Vet Certificate is not required.

The following instructions will ensure that the process is smooth:

1. Organise with the Registrar of the Morgan Horse Association *one month before* to make the Micro-Chip Scanner available on the required date and venue.
2. Photocopy the horses Registration Certificate. Take both the original and the photocopy to the measuring day.
3. On the day, show the measuring official the original certificate. Give them the copy as this will form part of their records.
4. Your horse will be scanned to verify the Micro Chip number corresponds with the number displayed on the scanner/certificate.
5. From this point, the process will proceed as per the usual Royal Agricultural Society Measuring Rules and Regulations.
